THE TRIMLINE JOINER TARP

If you are placing two TrimLine side by side they must be positioned with the arch of the roof going from front to back. Lash the legs of the canopy together. You may use your Ball Bungees for this purpose.

<u>SPECIAL NOTE:</u> When assembling rear legs where the two units meet, slide a StaBar Ell joint onto the bottom of each leg.

Joiner Tarp Installation

To install the TrimLine Joiner tarp, unroll the tarp over one of the 10x10 units while it is on the ground (i.e., before the legs are installed)- near the edge where the two will join. Temporarily tie off the center cord to the corner joint.

When the two units are assembled side by side on legs, scoot the joiner over till it covers the space where the two TrimLine roofs meet. Position the joiner so that the sewn-in plastic poles are just past the front of the upper horizontal (PURPLE coded) poles. Untie your temporary attachments and pass the end of the cord through the thumbscrew of one foot – then pass it back up through the loop in the line, and tie off.

To stabilize the joiner tarp against the wind, attach the cords on the outer grommets in the rear to the outer feet (the cords go diagonally across the backs of the units).
